
Syllabus and Its Transaction at the Institution




From the analysis of responses it is observed that maximum i.e. (62.22%) respondents opined that they are agree with syllabus of course they studied is satisfactory.










From the analysis of data it is observed that (75.55%) respondent opined that syllabus is helpful in overall personality development.


